第二节 书面表达 (满分 25 分)

一、评分原则

1. 本题总分为 25 分，按 5 个档次给分。
2. 评分时，先根据文章的内容和语言初步确定其所属档次，然后以该档次的要求来衡量，确定或调整档次，最后给分。
3. 词数少于 80 和多于 120 的，从总分中减去 2 分。
4. 评分时应注意的主要内容为：内容要点、应用词汇和语法结构的丰富性和准确性及上下文的连贯性。
5. 拼写与标点符号是语言准确性的一个方面，评分时，应视其对交际的影响程度予以考虑。英、美拼写及词汇用法均可接受。
6. 如书写较差以致影响交际，可将分数降低一个档次。

二、内容要点：

1. 做家务的原因；
2. 做家务的过程；
3. 你的感受。

三、要点认定：

1. 考生必须有较完整的句子表达出要点。如只有关键词而无主谓结构，不可视为要点写出。
2. 围绕要点的发挥，如有语言错误，则扣语言分。

四、扣分参考依据：

1. 表达未能达成正确句意的，不给分，如：写出了主语或谓语等关键词，但未能达成符合要点要求、意义正确的句子；
2. 句子结构完整、但关键点出现错误或漏掉部分关键词，扣半个要点分，如：主谓一致错误，或关键词拼写错误（如主语、关键性名词等），或谓语动词时态或语态错误等；
3. 凡使用铅笔答题、或答题中使用了涂改液或不干胶条，一律不给分；
4. 凡多次出现非关键性单词拼写错误或其它同类错误，原则上每 4 处扣 1 分；
5. 文章内容要点全面，但写出了一些多余内容（连接或过渡词句不在此列），原则上不扣分；
6. 书写潦草凌乱，但基本不影响阅卷的，酌情扣卷面分 1-2 分。

M: Hello. International Friends Club. Can I help you?

W: Oh, hello. I read about your club in the paper today and I thought I'd phone to find out a bit more.

M: Yes, certainly, well we're a sort of social club for people from different countries. It's quite a new club—we have about 50 members at the moment, but we're growing all the time.

W: That sounds interesting. I'm British actually, and I came to Washington about three months ago. I'm looking for ways to meet people. Er, what kinds of events do you organize?

M: Well, we have social get-togethers, and sports events, and we also have language evenings.

W: Could you tell me something about the language evenings?

M: Yes. Every day except Thursday we have a language evening. People can come and practice their languages—you know, over a drink or something. We have different languages on different evenings. Monday—Spanish; Tuesday—Italian; Wednesday—German; and Friday—French. On Thursday we usually have a meal in a restaurant for anyone who wants to come.

W: Well, that sounds great. I really need to practice my French.

M: Ok. Well, if you can just give me your name and address, I'll send you the form and some more information. If you join now, you can have the first month free.

W: Mark, I regret to tell you that our appointment, which is at 5:00 pm. on Friday, has to be put off. Because it's my turn to go to the hospital to look after my grandma.

M: It doesn't matter. Let's make it the same time next day. (停 10 秒)

M: I've decided I'm going to study art at university. I want to draw the pictures in children's books.

W: You would be so good at that. I can't decide what to do. My mom wants me to study law like she did, but I would rather study history. (停 10 秒)

M: I'm glad we're safe.

W: Yeah, it was terrifying. The road was so narrow as we went up and everyone seemed to be driving so fast as we came down. I'm surprised there were no accidents. (停 5 秒)

M: I suppose it's just my habit. I've always got eggs in the fridge. Sandwiches are easy to make. But to be honest, I am quite bored of eating them every day!

W: Interesting. Shall we forget the sandwiches today and have lunch in a local restaurant?

M: I suppose we could.

W: Come on, I'm hungry. We could try out that new place on the main street near our office. I fancy beef noodles.

W: Wow, such beautiful architecture. Maybe I would like Rome. **(停 10 秒)**

M: Well, I like Chinese paintings, especially Chinese landscape paintings.

W: Yes! They are beautiful. Well then, I'm sure that you shouldn't have left that early.

M: Why do you say so?

W: Actually, apart from some western paintings, there were a great number of Chinese paintings, including some famous Chinese landscape paintings as well. You couldn't have been bored if you had stayed.

M: Oh, what a pity! Would you accompany me to the exhibition after school?

W: No problem! **(停 15 秒)**

M: As a photographer, you are quite successful. Can you tell me who can become a photographer?

W: Anyone can become a photographer, as long as you want it. It's not like you need a degree or

certificate or anything. Yes, I've been planning to take photography classes in an art school in the UK, but before this, I'd already been working as a photographer for years—I started by using my phone in junior high. Some of my photographer friends do other jobs at the same time—they are music makers, vloggers and directors.

M: What does a photographer usually do?

W: There are different kinds of photographers and our lives and work can be quite different, too. A National Geographic kind of photographer may travel to different places, taking photos of architecture, landscapes and animals. But fashion photographers like me, mainly do two things—commercial shoots and our own creative projects. The former is for making money and offering service to customers. The latter is for expression—we post these photos on our own social media, submit them to media outlets and contests, or host photographic exhibitions to show them off.

M: What makes a good photographer?

W: For commercial shooting, there are some routines that we can follow and the most important thing is to meet the needs of our customers. For our own shoots, what matters most is that you have something that you want to express, and these things can be received or understood by a certain group of people who think similarly.

M: Welcome to our program. Today's topic is Getting Two Shy People to Talk to Each Other.

Perhaps you know two people aren't intentionally avoiding one another when they first meet; it's just not in their nature to start a conversation. Actually, you can help them. Don't worry that your shy friends will feel uncomfortable. In fact, they might be grateful that you help them get past the initial awkwardness.

The first step to get two shy people to talk is to offer an introduction. If you see them sitting together but not talking, walk over and be an ice breaker. A brief introduction with a piece of information that ties them together will be most helpful.

Some shy people tend to tell themselves that they are not good enough. They think that everyone else is judging them. You may be able to help by building their social confidence and belief that they are liked.

Last but not least, figure out what your shy friends have in common and let them know about it. For example, if they are both into basketball, make a comment about the latest game. You might need to include yourself in the conversation at first, but once they become involved in their favorite topic, you can quietly slip away. (停 20 秒)
